## Just as a reminder here are some of the long standing rules of the Western Rifle League.

- Teams can only use the scores of dues paid club members. Guests are welcome to shoot for score only.

- Empty Chamber Indicators will be required (Same as any NRA match)
- > Rifles will not be handled in the range while people are down range servicing targets.
- Alternative shooting positions for physically impaired shooters needs to be approved by the three team captains annually. These shooters will be asked to explain their impairment and will have to use the official alternative disabled positions set by the NRA for physically impaired shooters.
